Vineyard

Logsdon Ridge Vineyard has been managed by Dai since 2002. Owned by the Rudolph family and known to our team as *Rudolfo*, this small 10-acre vineyard is planted entirely to Pinot Gris. Located just north of Corvallis, Oregon, it is a warm, low elevation site that ripens very early.

Vintage Notes

From a small, warm site near Corvallis planted just to pinot gris, this wine is thrillingly grippy and austere, with scents of almond flour and lemon, and lean green-appley flavors. Pretty much bursting with acidity, and buoyed on a cushion of sourdough lees, this is built for Willapa Bay oysters on the half shell.
